


INSTALLATION

CAUTION: DISCONNECT ORGAN POWER BEFORE PROCEEDING!


- 1. Mount the echo and tremolo control switches on the wooden rail in front of the lower manual, using the wood screws provided.
- 2. Route the control cables under the lower manual, through the keyboard shelf, and into the amplifier section of the console. If no opening is provided, drill a 1-inch hole in the keyboard shelf just under the lower manual. Be careful to select a location where no internal components will be damaged.
- 3. Mount the console connector chassis inside the console within reach of the adapter and control cables, using the wood screws provided.
- 4. Plug the echo and tremolo control cables into the proper sockets on the console connector.
- 5. Unplug the cable from the SPEAKER socket on the organ amplifier and plug it into the adapter socket. (A, figure 1) This installation routes only the flute tones to the LESLIE speaker.

- 6. Plug the adapter into the SPEAKER socket on the organ amplifier. (A)
- 7. Plug the adapter power cord into a **SWITCHED** 117VAC socket on the organ amplifier. (B)
- 8. Fit the 5-pin socket onto the plug marked CONSOLE, on the console connector.
- 9. Plug the LESLIE speaker cable into the socket marked LESLIE SPKR. on the console connector.
- 10. Follow the load resistor setting instructions for the 8-0HM position, as outlined in the LESLIE service manual.
- 11. If necessary, adjust speaker volume.


