CAUTION: Due to the presence of electrical potential and the danger of moving mechanical parts, installation procedures or adjustments requiring work inside the LESLIE speaker cabinet or the organ console should be performed only by a service man authorized by the dealer or factory to perform such work.

### **INSTALLATION**


CAUTION: DISCONNECT ORGAN POWER BEFORE PROCEEDING!

- 1. Remove the back panel from the organ.
- 2. Mount the echo switch under the keyboard shelf, left or right, as the organist prefers. Wood screws are provided.
- 3. Route the control cables through the keyboard shelf and into the area where the amplifier is located. If no hole is provided in the keyboard shelf, drill a 1-inch diameter hole, being careful to select a location where no internal components will be damaged.
- 4. Locate the 9-contact socket (B on interconnection figure) on the right side of the organ amplifier (viewed from the rear).
- 5. Remove the plug from this socket; connect the plug to socket S4 of the interceptor from the console connector kit. (B)
- 6. Connect the plug of the interceptor (P5) to the socket on the organ amplifier left vacant by step 5.
- 7. Mount the console connector on the bottom shelf of the organ.
- 8. Connect the plug of the echo control to the socket marked ECHO SW., on the console connector.

- 9. Connect the adapter (socket S2) to the plug marked CONSOLE, on the console connector.
- 10. Connect the cable assembly which comes in the kit between the console connector and the LESLIE speaker.
- 11. Replace the back panel on the organ. (A slot is provided for the cable.)

# **Ordering Parts**

Standard hardware, connectors, and electronic components should be purchased locally. Non-standard items may be obtained through a LESLIE speaker dealer. Orders should include part numbers as listed.




